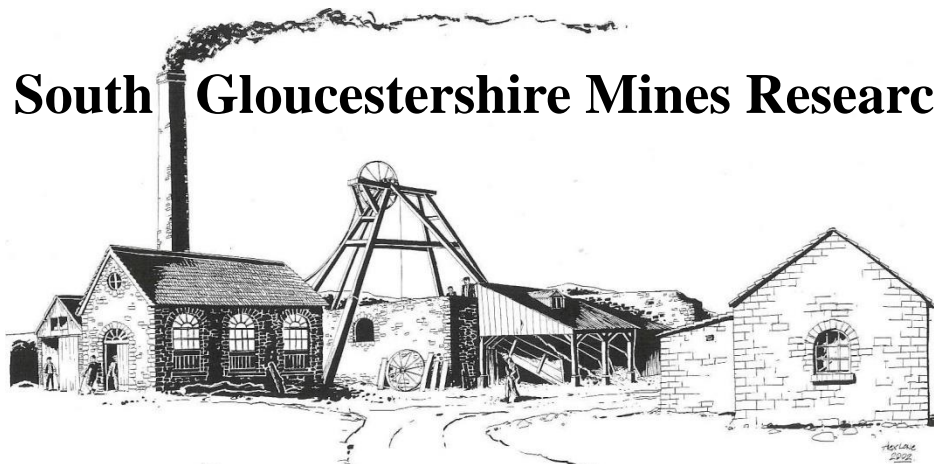

Our AGM and a “Boring” Talk !!! (see below)

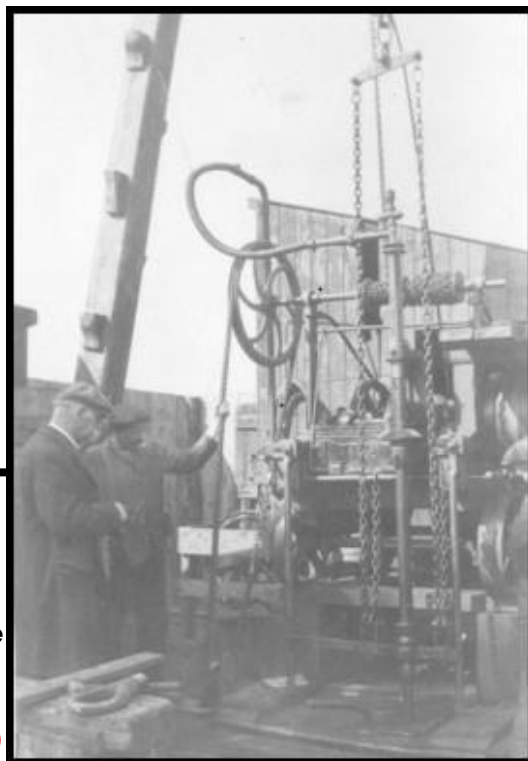
